

Wardens Peer Interaction Program

The Correctional Management Institute of Texas (CMIT) would like to thank you for your interest in participating in the *Wardens Peer Interaction Program.* This program is hosted by CMIT and the North American Association of Wardens & Superintendents (NAAWS). The next program will be held May 17-20, 2021, at the Hyatt Centric, located in The Woodlands, Texas.

This program is designed for Wardens and Superintendents, including Deputy and/or Assistant Wardens and Superintendents. It provides an excellent opportunity for participants to interact with their peers to discuss current management and direction for prison/jail operations and programs, as well as time to explore best practices and prepare strategies for handling critical correctional challenges. To aide in the facilitation of the program, participants will be asked to present a topic of critical concern or best practice within their agency or facility. Each presentation will be followed by a discussion period for all attendees to actively participate in.

We ask that selected participants schedule travel for arrival to The Woodlands, Texas by 3:00 p.m. on Monday, May 17, 2021. Transportation will be provided for those who fly into George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH), in Houston, Texas by 2:00 p.m. on May 17, 2021. Participants will be asked to prepare a 20-minute presentation (in conjunction with another attendee from the same agency, if applicable) to present to the group for discussion. Participants will also be encouraged to provide a memento to present to each of the participants and facilitators.

The program fee covers all training materials, lunches, and dinners (breakfast is included with your stay at the Hyatt Centric) and transportation from and to the George Bush Intercontinental Airport.

As our field continues figuring out what moving forward looks like, CMIT is no exception. We don't know what the future holds, but we can make a few guarantees to our participants. The safety of our attendees and staff is top priority and we remain in constant communication with the hosts at the Hyatt Centric. All necessary precautions will be taken to offer you a face-to-face event where you feel comfortable while adhering to all recommended guidelines.
