This program is hosted by CMIT and the North American Association of Wardens & Superintendents (NAAWS). The next program will be held October 3-7, 2022, at the George J. Beto Criminal Justice Center, located on the campus of Sam Houston State University in Huntsville, Texas.

This program is designed for Wardens and Superintendents, including Deputy and/or Assistant Wardens and Superintendents. It provides an excellent opportunity for participants to interact with their peers to discuss current management and direction for prison/jail operations and programs, as well as time to explore best practices and prepare strategies for handling critical correctional challenges. To aid in the facilitation of the program, participants will be asked to submit a topic of critical concern or best practice within their agency or facility, for approval by CMIT. Participants will then be asked to prepare a 15 to 20-minute presentation regarding their approved topic (in conjunction with another attendee from the same agency, if applicable). Each presentation will be followed by a discussion period.

The \$675 program fee covers all training materials, classroom coffee and snacks, lunches, dinners, and transportation from and to the George Bush Intercontinental Airport. All other costs to include the University Hotel (breakfast is included with your stay at the University Hotel) is not covered.

To apply for participation, please complete (required fields are indicated in red, must be completed in pdf format) the below application, in its entirety, and submit it by email to the program contact on or before August 15, 2022 (application information is shared with all participants during the program). Agencies are encouraged to send participants in teams of two. The 36 selected participants will be notified no later than August 22, 2022. Selection notification will include additional logistical and program information.
